SALARY RELIEF GRANT

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible to a grant of \$1,500 or part thereof if all of these apply:

- You are between the ages of 18 - 65.
- You are a citizen/permanent resident living in Trinidad & Tobago during the period of the Grant.
- You have suffered involuntary termination, suspension or loss of income between March 19th to June 30th as a result of Covid-19 health and safety measures (employees of bars, hotels, restaurants, etc).
- You have no other source of income.
- You are registered under the NIS.
- Your last or present employer is registered under the NIS.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

- 1 - A completed application form.
- 2 - Copy of national identification card/driver's permit/passport.
- 3 - Proof of citizenship (National ID card) or permanent residence in Trinidad and Tobago.
- 4 - Last payslip issued in the month preceding or the month of termination or suspension.
- 5 - A recent bank or credit union statement (if applicable) (not older than 3 months) or a letter from the individual's bank or credit union indicating the relevant account holder and number.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1 - Download the application form from www.nibtt.net or collect one from ANY police station in Trinidad & Tobago from April 9th.
- 2 - Fill out ALL sections of the SRG application form.
- 3 - Present or last employer MUST complete the relevant section on the form.
- 4 - Copy or scan all supporting documents.
- 5 - Email completed application and supporting documents to srg@gov.tt or drop off at named locations.

Please Note:

Application forms will be available online from Wednesday April 8th, 2020 and from ANY Police Station in Trinidad & Tobago from Thursday April 9th, 2020. Online applications can begin immediately.

In-Person applications are invited for submission from Tuesday April 14th, 2020. Persons outside of the NIS system will be dealt with in phase 2 of the Grant.

APPLICANTS ARE URGED TO USE THE ONLINE APPLICATION ROUTE TO AVOID PUBLIC GATHERING. IN AN EFFORT TO ADHERE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING PROTOCOLS DURING THIS COVID-19 PANDEMIC, THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE WILL ANNOUNCE SAFE DROP OFF LOCATIONS BETWEEN FRIDAY 10TH - MONDAY 13TH, APRIL.

Payments will be made via bank/credit union accounts or a cheque.
